Sub: Implementation of New National Permit Scheme.

Reference on the subject cited above.

The Govt. of India has implemented a new National Permit Scheme vide its Notification No.GSR 386(E) dated 7th May, 2010 (copy enclosed). As per the Notification, the following amendments have been made with regard to the National Permit fee:-

1. The amended rules provide for levy of Rs. 1000/- towards home State authorization fee and Rs. 15000/- towards consolidated fee per annum per vehicle, authorizing the national permit holder to operate throughout the country, formula for distribution of the consolidated fee among the States/UTs and consequential changes in the relevant forms namely form 23A, 46 and 47. The Ministry has also completed the process of opening of a National Permit Account in the State Bank of India with the approval of Controller General of Accounts (CGA) to facilitate collection of such consolidated fee and subsequent distribution thereof.
2. In order to implement the new National Permit system with immediate effect, the National Permit issuing authorities shall have to follow the following procedure: -
 - i) The concerned authority shall verify the application for national permit and other relevant documents needed for grant of National Permit such as age of the vehicle, valid fitness and insurance, payment of all taxes etc.
 - ii) An amount of Rs.15,000/- - towards consolidated fee shall be deposited by cash or Demand Draft drawn on State Bank of India (payable at the location where consolidated fee is deposited) through prescribed challan in the designated branch of the State Bank of India. A format of the challan is enclosed. The list of the State bank Branches which have been authorized is enclosed.
 - iii) The concerned branch of the State bank of India shall submit a scroll of collection of consolidated fee to the corresponding RTO on day-today basis. The RTO in turn shall check the genuineness of payment of consolidated fee and may consider grant/renewal of national permit
 - iv) The concerned authority shall collect an amount of Rs.1,000/- towards home State authorization fee' as per their own procedure of collection of fee.
 - v) The authorization for national permit shall be issued for operation of the vehicle throughout the territory of India. This shall be indicated on the national permit to be issued by the concerned authority.

- vi) Proper records of grant/renewal of national permit (vehicle-wise), shall be maintained by the national permit issuing authorities. A statement shall be sent to the O/o Transport Commissioner, Haryana, Chandigarh who in turn will consolidate the data in respect of all the national permit issuing authorities in the State and send the same to the Ministry of Govt. of India on a weekly basis to enable the Ministry to ensure cross checking with SBI relating to payment of consolidated fee and subsequent devolution of funds accordingly. Once the necessary software is developed in consultation with NIC for the purpose of issuance of national permit and instructions to that effect are issued, the information relating to the national permit issued during the interim period shall be uploaded in that format.
- vii) Necessary stamps, indicating authorization for operation of the vehicle through the territory of India on the national permit should be prepared with due entries as authorized by concerned Secretary, RTA.

You all are directed to implement the New National Permit Scheme with effect from today i.e. 25/5/2010 positively in view of the directions given above and compliance be reported through Fax.
